Rural Energy for America Program: Due June 20

Renewable Energy Systems & Energy Efficiency Improvement Loans & Grants in



Montana.

A program for small business and agricultural producers to acquire loan and grant funding to make energy efficiency improvements. New energy efficient equipment and new system loans for ag production and processing.

Local Meat Capacity Grant: Due July 19

This USDA program supports independently owned meat and poultry processing businesses with funding to improve processing options for local livestock producers.

Growth Through Agriculture: Pre-application release in early fall

The GTA's primary grant and loan program was created to support news jobs and expand small business opportunities through the development of agricultural innovation and commercial expansion. This is an extensive application with a short application submission window. Start considering application requirements now!
